### Directions to the Water For Life Reception

City Hall is conveniently located at 450 110th Ave. NE (Northeast Fourth Street and 110th Avenue Northeast)

The most convenient off-ramp from I-405 is at Northeast Fourth Street (Exit 13A).

From Seattle via Hwy 520: Take State Route 520 east over the Evergreen Point Bridge to I-405 south. Go south on I-405 and take Exit 13A west (Northeast Fourth Street westbound). Go one block and make a right turn on 110th Avenue Northeast. Proceed to the City Hall visitor parking entrance on the right.

From Seattle via I-90: Take I-90 east over Lake Washington. Merge north onto I-405 (exit 10). Take Exit 13A west (Northeast Fourth Street westbound). Turn right on 110th Avenue Northeast. Proceed to the City Hall visitor parking entrance on the right.
