1. EXPAND REACH

- Recruit instructors in Central Washington and Eastern Oregon subsections
- Basic Waterworks was presented in February by Jeff Lundt and two new instructors and planning again for Olympic Peninsula this spring.
- Arc Flash & Electrical course is in need of additional instructors.

2. Basic Water Works

- We are currently working the Michigan Subsection who wishes to purchase the BWW course.
- This is a onetime purchase with acknowledgements to our Subsection for development.
- Once the agreement is written we will present it to the board.
- This was generated from our listing in WaterX.

3. Emergency Preparedness

- Developing another Training in a Box course for 0.6 CEUs.
- A test run has been scheduled for May 24th in Port Townsend. Registration is now open.
- Recruiting additional instructors.

4. Construction Management

- We have begun looking at the agenda and discussing the possibility for developing this as our next TIAB program.

5. ASSISTING OTHERS
