The Committee is currently receiving applications for this year's scholarships, due March 8, 2019. As of early February, we have received 26 applications, so we are on track to outpace the number of applicants from previous years.

As always, we distributed scholarship information and applications details to all our subsections and to educational institutions throughout the northwest which support water-related training. As in previous years, the scholarship application is submitted by students on-line, via the Section website. In addition, students are requested to have their colleges submit official transcripts electronically, effectively eliminating paper from the scholarship submission and review process.

The committee will review applications on-line via a shared workspace in March, present award recommendations to the Section Chair in early April and recognize awardees at the Annual Conference in Vancouver.

We look forward to continuing this important support for drinking water workforce and career development and appreciate the Board's leadership.
