2nd Place – 54.30 seconds, Dan Azzato, EWEB

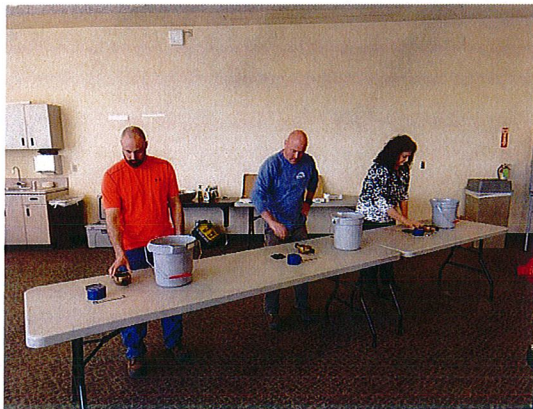
3rd Place – 56.10 seconds, Eric Carlson, Rainbow Water District
