AWIA Compliance Required RRA and ERP Review or Development

EPA template provided a starting point NOT objective First round emphasis seemingly by default was on RRA

**Next Compliance dates:**

3,301 – 49,999 June 30, 2026		December 31, 2026	

## **Observations From Round 1**

01	Focus was on RRA, but ERP is functional part of process	05	Review and training was lacking
02	Compliance met but not comfortable ERPs rose to the level of functionality	06	ERPs bogged down in detail OR were too generic to be functional
03	Adequate for individual isolated emergencies	07	Weak clarity of authority
04	ERPs did not carry over to system-wide outages	What's Your Status?




Can you benefit from vehicles in the field 24/7?

Can you leverage staff locations for dispersal of response equipment?


Would dispersed regional response centers provide response flexibility or resilience?

# **Managing Prevention and Mitigation**

- Hazard
- Description of Risk
- Goal/Function/Assets at Risk
- Preventative Controls
- Mitigative Controls


Score	Consequence	Score	Likelihood		
1	Insignificant	1	Rare		
2	Minor	2	Unlikely		
3	Moderate	3	Possible		
4	Major	4	Likely		
5	Catastrophic	5	Almost Certain		
Risk Score = Consequence y Likelihood					

#### Risk Score = Consequence x Likelihood






#### **Response Resources Are Not Limitless - Prioritize**



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- You have *compliance*, but do you have *functionality*
- A self-evaluation doesn't have to wait until next AWIA update
- Consider flipping focus from RRA to ERP next cycle
- Review the usability and training of ERP
- RRA was a snap-shot assessment, ERP is on-going activity
