The named funds continue to grow, especially the Subsection funds. South Sound Subsection's fund reached the \$10,000 mark and now is providing an annual scholarship.

There were two new named funds started in the past year: Dan Bradley and Operator Certification Scholarship Program.

Named funds contributed \$37,896 to scholarships for 2024. Additional funds from retained earnings \$12,000 for a total available (including funding Short School scholarships and the Operator Certification Scholarships) of \$50,000 in 2024.
